Happenings at the Library for June

June is National Oceans Month and the theme, **Oceans of Possibilities**, is being used this summer for the summer reading program and for the four outstanding programs that will be presented in the auditorium during June.

The DeLand Warboats at Normandy, with an optional short feature, **The Quest to Return ST479Tiger** will be presented on June 6 at 1:00 by Dan Friend, President/Military Curator of the DeLand Historic Trust, Inc.

On June 17 at 1:00, **Let's Talk Turtles** will be the topic of Carolyn Kovacs, Florida Sea Grant Agent from the UF/IFAS Extension of Flagler and Volusia Counties. She will tell about the different species in Volusia County.

On June 20 at 1:00, John Mann, Lead Docent from the Ponce Inlet Lighthouse and Museum, will discuss lighthouses throughout the world with a special emphasis on the topic, **Three Lighthouses of Volusia County**.

On June 30 at 1:00, Zach Zacharias, Senior Curator of Education and Curator of History at the Museum of Arts and Sciences Daytona Beach, will have as his topic, **Introduction to the Vikings**, as he tells of the tremendous impact the Vikings had on the history and culture of Western civilization.

An important topic to be discussed on June 2 at 10:00, is entitled **Halifax Program: Five Wishes**. It describes a Living Will that talks about your personal, emotional and spiritual needs and your medical wishes.

On June 24 at 1:00, the League of Women Voters of Volusia County will discuss **Senate Bill 90**, which when passed in 2021, made major changes to Florida's voting laws.

Other activities going on at the library include movies every Monday at 10:00.
